Founded in 1963 as the only independent college preparatory school on Cleveland's west side, Lake Ridge Academy serves approximately 420 students with an upper school enrollment of approximately 150. Lake Ridge Academy is accredited by the Independent Schools Association of the Central States and chartered by the State of Ohio as a college preparatory school.

Students are not eligible to register for an AP course until Junior year. A student may only take up to 3 AP courses in an academic year unless special permission is granted by the Head of Upper School.

GRADING & BANKING

Because of the relatively small class size and the strong quality of our graduating classes, Lake Ridge Academy does not rank. We compute semester and cumulative academic GPAs in grades 8 -12. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, all grades for semester two of the 2019-2020 academic year were pass/fail. While Lake Ridge Academy posts only final semester grades, the spring 2020 third quarter grades have been factored into the student GPA. Our GPA does not include grades earned at any other institution. Honors courses are weighted by .33 and Advanced Placement courses are weighted by .67.

SCHOOL OF FINE ARTS (SOFA)

The School of Fine Arts provides talented students with greater access to a comprehensive fine arts curriculum. Areas of focus include voice, musical theater, acting, strings, instrumental jazz, visual art, and digital art. Students present two public displays of their work in their sophomore and senior years, respectively. The public display initially helps guide their focus and later serves as the graduation exit requirement.

INSTITUTE FOR SCIENTIFIC RESEARCH

Beginning sophomore year, Fellows in the Institute for Scientific Research design and implement an original research project that continues throughout the junior and senior years. Drawing from primary literature, Fellows develop a firm background and context for their research. Data collection and statistical analysis eventually leads to the completion of a major research paper and public defense of their hypothesis and findings.

INSTITUTE FOR ENGINEERING AND INNOVATION

The Institute for Engineering and Innovation provides students with the facilities and academic support to extensively explore a chosen field of engineering. The Institute is designed to introduce the participants to the engineering design process and prepare them for college entry-level engineering coursework.

GLOBAL AND INTERNATIONAL STUDIES PROGRAM

The Global and International Studies Program develops the student's global awareness and overall intrinsic motivation to make a positive difference by learning the tools and guidelines to advocate for policy change. In their junior year, Global Scholars focus on a specialized Area of Study that includes a knowledgebased presentation to a panel of experts at the end of the year. The culminating project is the defense of an extensive proposed policy paper in their senior year.
